



## Medical First Responders

---

The Saddle Hills County Medical First Responders are medically trained and equipped volunteers who provide initial patient care in areas of the County with prolonged ambulance response times. As a result of the significant distances involved for emergency medical response, Saddle Hills County implemented the Medical Response Program in 2000, the implementation of the program has seen a significant reduction in primary response times. The Medical First Responders also work with the volunteer firefighters as required.

The Saddle Hills County level of service policy is to identify the emergency services Saddle Hills County Fire Departments and Saddle Hills County Medical Co-Responders are authorized to provide and identify the level or standard to which each service will be performed.
