

## Road Bans in Effect

Pursuant to the Saddle Hills County By-Law 80-1998 and policy no. PW04, effective 8:00 a.m. on May 24th, 2011 the following allowable axle weight loading shall be enforced on Saddle Hills County roads:

- All Bridges as posted;
- 75% Axle Weight Loading on Twp Rd. 115 (also known as the Pillsworth Road) from Hwy. 49 north to S.H. 618;
- 75% Axle Weight Loading on Twp Road 814 from Range Road 133 west to Range Road 134;
- 100% Axle Weight Loading on all other gravel roads.
