



## 2009 Infrastructure Improvement Program



Saddle Hills County has received **\$1.5 million** in Resource Road grant funding re-grade the Pillsworth Road. The initial stage of this project will span from HWY681 to TWP795 and will include the replacement of two bridge structures.

In December of 2007 **\$1.3 million** of Canada-Alberta Municipal Rural Infrastructure Funding was received to re-align the

road traversing the Doe River valley. This project will involve construction of a retaining structure, road construction and some road re-grading.

Saddle Hills County is committed to the provision of a safe corridor for the travelling public. As such, various construction projects are planned in addition to the aforementioned developments.
