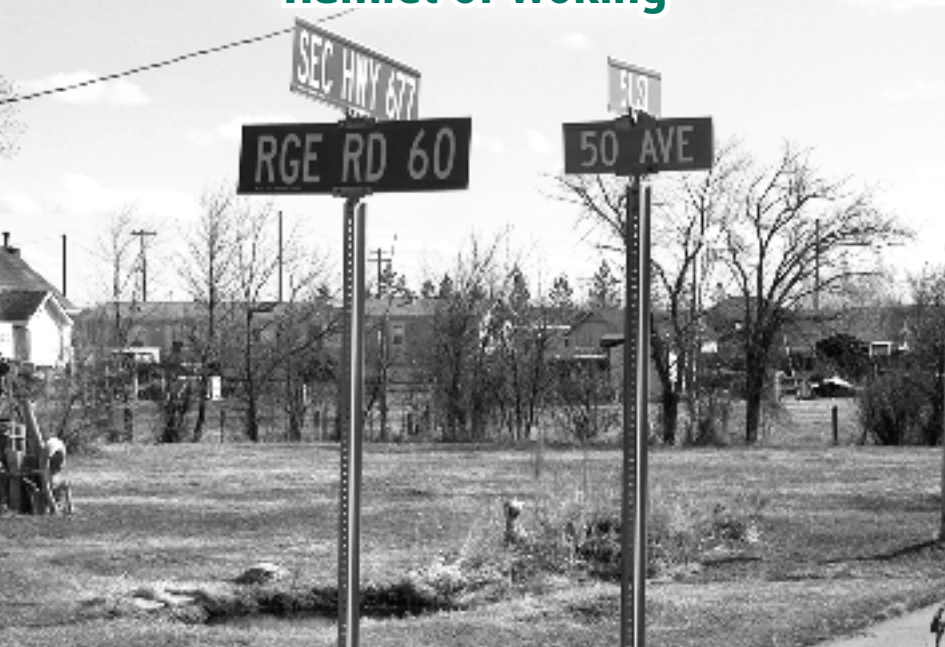




VISIONING OPEN HOUSE FOR THE Hamlet of Woking
