Rental Equipment**

The Saddle Hills County ASB owns several pieces of rental equipment that are available for ratepayer use at a reasonable cost. Note that GST to be added to rental rates.

EQUIPMENT	DAMAGE DEPOSIT	RENTAL PER DAY
Livestock Tag Reader	\$200	First two days free \$25 per additional day
Tree Planter	\$100	\$10 per day
Electric Sprayers	\$100	\$10 per day
Transit	\$100	\$10 per day
5 1/2 yard Scraper	\$300	\$60 per day for the first 3 days and \$85 per day for each of the following days.
8 1/2 yard Scraper	\$300	\$90 per day for the first 3 days and \$115 per day for each of the following days.
Cat 70 (13 1/2 yard)	\$500	\$120 per day. Maximum rental of 3 days.
