**Home Support Services In Saddle Hills County?**

Home Support Services is the provision of home care to families and individuals experiencing disruption of normal family routine in situations such as pre or post natal home care, supplemental care for seniors, and pre or post hospitalization. Home support workers could provide assistance with basic housekeeping, meal preparation, driving clients to appointments and/or respite for caregivers.

An assessment of need would be conducted and agreed to by both parties. The recipient would be expected to provide the home care worker with the necessary materials to

complete the assigned tasks. Fees would be charged for these services and agreed to, before the service would begin.

Saddle Hills County Council is interested in knowing if County residents are aware of a need for this type of home support service that is not already provided by another agency or private business.
