Fence Removal & Installation

Saddle Hills County is currently seeking quotations for fence removal and installation for the 2010 season. All fencing shall be 4 Strand Class "B" which will include all labour, material and equipment to complete the installation.

Please list separate pricing for:

- Existing fence removal per lineal meter
- New fence installation per lineal meter

Class "B" fence specifications:

- Line posts - 2.13m long with 100-125mm top dia. maximum spacing 3.75m.
- Gate stays - 1.2m long with 55mm top dia. Or 1.2m long twisted wire.
- Gate, intersection and end corner posts - 2.44m long with 175mm top dia.
- Intermediate bracing post spacing 3m maximum.
- Angle bracing posts - 100mm x 100mm x 3.75m.
- 3.66mm thick soft galvanized wire for diagonal bracing.
- 40mm staples.
- Barbed wire - single strand 2.64mm thick or four point galvanized 2.5mm thick strands.

Notes:

- All fence posts shall be pressure treated.
- Butt ends of posts shall be placed down.
