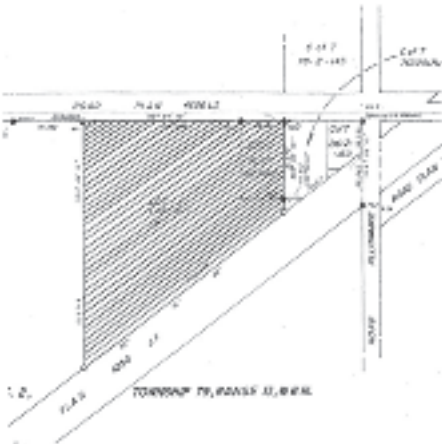

Rezone from Country Residential (CRI) District to Rural Industrial (RI) District

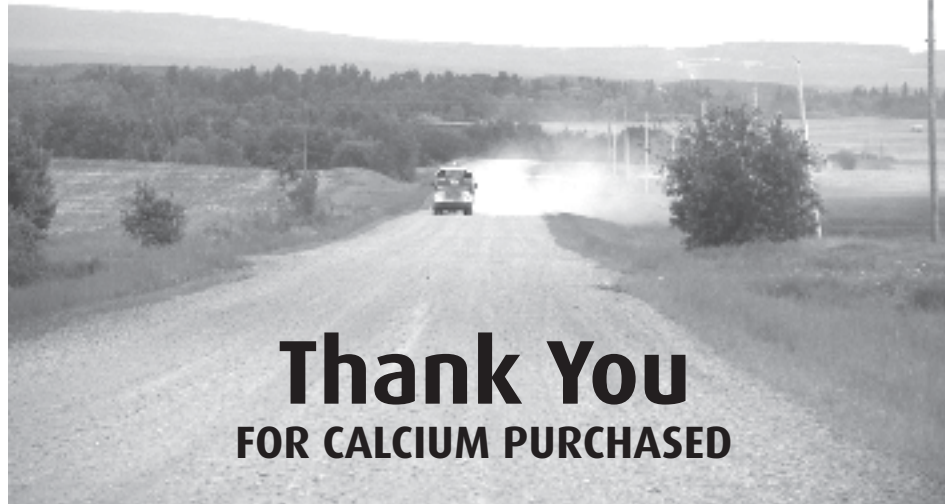


Area to rezoned shown thus
