PURPOSE:

To identify the emergency services the Saddle Hills County Fire Departments and Saddle Hills Medical Co-Responders are authorized to provide and identify the level or standard to which each service will be performed.

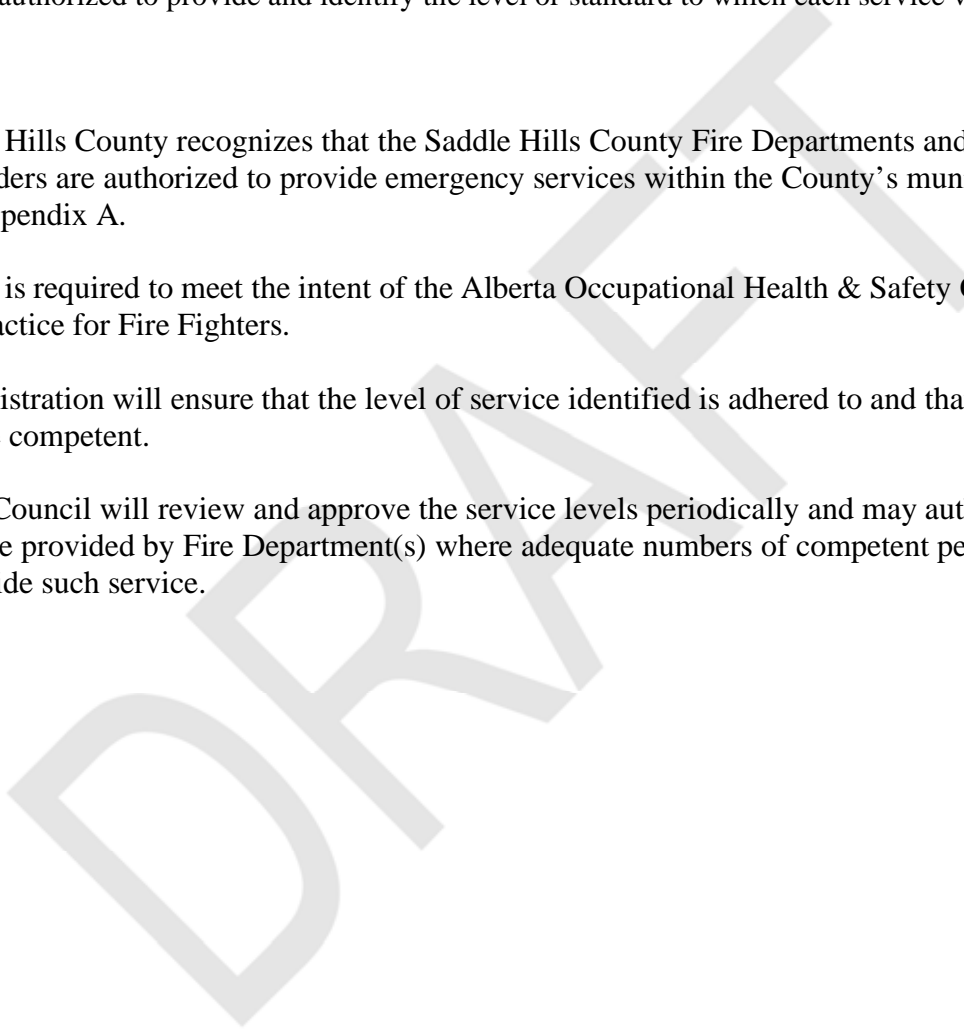
POLICY:

The Saddle Hills County recognizes that the Saddle Hills County Fire Departments and Saddle Hills Medical Co-Responders are authorized to provide emergency services within the County’s municipal boundary area, as listed in Appendix A.

This policy is required to meet the intent of the Alberta Occupational Health & Safety Code and the Alberta Code of Practice for Fire Fighters.

Fire Administration will ensure that the level of service identified is adhered to and that volunteers providing services are competent.

Municipal Council will review and approve the service levels periodically and may authorize a higher level of service to be provided by Fire Department(s) where adequate numbers of competent personnel are available to safely provide such service.
