<p><b><u>PURPOSE:</u></b></p> <p>To direct administration by stipulating which beaver dams are eligible to be removed by the County</p> <p><b><u>POLICY:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. First priority on the removal of beaver dams will be given to beaver dams which are directly affecting the municipality's infrastructure.</li> <li>2. Second priority on the removal of beaver dams will be given to beaver dams within ½ mile of the municipality's infrastructure which have the potential of affecting the municipality's infrastructure.</li> <li>3. Municipal infrastructure is defined in this policy to include developed roads and environmental drainage ditches over which the County has control.</li> <li>4. Permission will be obtained from the landowners if proceeding outside the municipal Rights-of-ways.</li> </ol>
