Preparedness

The five municipalities in the Central Peace Region have formed a Partnership for Emergency Management (formerly known as Disaster Services). The Partnership is authorized by a Ministerial Order and allows the five municipalities to function as a single organization during a major emergency.

This program takes advantage of the combined strength and resources of the partners and eliminates competition for resources during an emergency. The CP-REM is authorized to declare a single State of Local Emergency which affects multiple municipalities.
