



BYLAW 360-2019
SADDLE HILLS COUNTY / BIRCH HILLS COUNTY
INTERMUNICIPAL COLLABORATION FRAMEWORK BYLAW

PURPOSE: A bylaw to establish an intermunicipal collaboration framework between the Saddle Hills County and Birch Hills County.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 708.28 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, and amendments thereto, municipalities that have common boundaries must, within 2 years from the coming into force of this section, create a framework with each other; and

WHEREAS, the Saddle Hills County and Birch Hills County and have a common boundary with one another; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 708.33 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, and amendments thereto, municipalities must create a framework by adopting matching bylaws that contain the framework.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Saddle Hills County in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Saddle Hills County / Birch Hills County Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework, attached hereto, is adopted;
2. That this Bylaw may be cited as the "Saddle Hills County / Birch Hills County ICF Bylaw"; and
3. This Bylaw shall come into effect upon the date of the final reading thereof.
