Do Not Spray Agreements are now available for 2023 either online or at the County Office. The deadline to submit agreements is **May 31**, **2023** at 4:30 p.m.

Fenceline Spraying Agreements are now available for 2023 either online or at the County Office. The deadline to submit agreements is **May 31, 2023** at 4:30 p.m.

DUST CONTROL APPLICATIONS OPEN

Each year Saddle Hills County offers dust control treatments on roads in front of residences at a cost approved by Council. Rates for 2023 are as follows:

- Residential: \$200 (plus GST) per 100m
- Industrial: \$670 (plus GST) per 100m
