

FIRE ADVISORY IN EFFECT

As a result of the high temperatures and drying conditions, the Fire Danger Rating in Saddle Hills County is now HIGH. In response to this, Saddle Hills County has issued a FIRE ADVISORY, along with other local municipalities. Controlled burning in the Non-Forest Protection Area, including on privately-owned land, is now limited to campfires, burning barrels, and hand-piled wood, two cubic metres or smaller. Burn permits are still required and will be issued on a case-by-case basis. Large fuel burns will not be permitted at this time. To check for Fire Advisories, Fire Restrictions and Fire Bans, visit albertafirebans.ca The Fire Advisory will remain in effect until conditions improve.

DUST CONTROL APPLICATIONS OPEN

Each year, Saddle Hills County offers dust control treatments on roads in front of residences at a cost approved by Council. Rates for 2025 are as follows:

- Residential: \$200 (plus GST) per 100m
- Industrial: \$670 (plus GST) per 100m

RESERVATIONS NOW OPEN FOR 2025 CAMPING SEASON

Reservations are now open for Hilltop Lake, Cotillion Park, and Moonshine Lake Provincial Park. Bookings for Cotillion Park and Hilltop Lake Campgrounds can be made through letscamp.ca, while sites at Moonshine Lake can be reserved through the Alberta Parks Reservation System. We are still working to determine opening dates and reservations at Spring Lake Campground, and we will provide an update as soon as this information is available. NOTICE OF ROAD BANS

With spring temperatures arriving, the County may implement Road Bans to protect the road surface from heavy vehicle damage. We also issue Road Ban Exemptions for companies and farmers that have Road Use Agreements and need to continue using certain roads. Currently, there are no Road Bans in place, however; this could change quickly dependent on weather conditions. Road Bans will be posted online at saddlehills.ab.ca/RoadBans, and an updated list can be provided by the County office.

2025 DO NOT SPRAY AGREEMENTS - NOW AVAILABLE

The tentative spray areas for 2025 are the Savanna, Fourth Creek, and Bonanza areas. If you do not wish to have the roadside beside your property sprayed by the County, you will need to complete a Do Not Spray Agreement. Do Not Spray Agreements are now available either online at saddlehills.ab.ca/weedcontrol or at the County office. The deadline to submit agreements is May 30, 2025, at 4:30 p.m.

2025 FENCELINE SPRAYING AGREEMENTS - NOW AVAILABLE

If you would like the fenceline along your property sprayed as part of our spraying program, you will need to complete a Fenceline Spraying Agreement. 
RURAL POTABLE WATER PROGRAM
