DUST CONTROL APPLICATIONS OPEN

Each year, Saddle Hills County offers dust control treatments on roads in front of residences at a cost approved by Council. Rates for 2024 are as follows:

Residential: \$200 (plus GST) per 100m Industrial: \$670 (plus GST) per 100m
