Please note that the Saddle Hills County Administration Building will be closed on **Monday, August 7, 2023**, for Heritage Day. We will reopen at 8:15 a.m. on Tuesday, August 8.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION - RANGE ROAD 135 & RANGE ROAD 95

Saddle Hills County is currently completing reconstruction work on Range Road 135, South of Township Road 765, for two miles and on Range Road 95 (Silver Valley Road), from Township Road 794 to Township Road 800. There is a fair weather detour in place on Range Road 95; signs are posted. Traffic may use Range Road 101 for two

miles West, while conditions allow. Should there be a period of prolonged rain traffic will be redirected back onto Range Road 95. A map is available on our website, or by scanning the QR code. We ask that all vehicles please drive with caution through the work zone and be aware of construction equipment in the area.



RECYCLE - PLEASE BAG YOUR PESTICIDE CONTAINERS

Bonanza, Blueberry, and Woking Transfer Stations continue to accept pesticide containers (with contents less than 23l) for recycling. Please note that in order for containers to be accepted they **must** be bagged. Bags are available from retailers at the time of purchase and a small inventory is kept on hand at participating transfer stations. Please bag your containers prior to drop-off, if possible.

A reminder that the deadline for 2023 property taxes is July 31, 2023. As of August 1, 2023 there will be a 6% penalty applied to the current year's outstanding tax balance.
