WORKING WELL WEBINAR - APR. 27

Saddle Hills County's Agricultural Services Department is hosting a FREE Working Well webinar on April 27, 2023 from 6:30-9:30 p.m. This comprehensive workshop will cover the basics of groundwater and how your well works, as well as information on how to protect your well, test your well water, operating and maintaining your well, what to do with old, abandoned wells on your property, and much more. Technical expertise will be provided by professionals

from Alberta Agriculture and Irrigation, Alberta Environment and Protected Areas, Alberta Health Services, and licensed well water contractors. Registration is required in advance. Registration closes April 27 at 4:30 p.m.

NOTICE OF ROAD BANS

With Spring temperatures due to arrive the County may implement Road Bans to protect the road surface from heavy vehicle damage. We also issue Road Ban Exemptions for companies and farmers that have Road Use Agreements and need to continue using certain roads. Currently there are no Road Bans in place, however this could change quickly dependent on weather conditions. Road Bans will be posted online and an updated list can be provided by the County office.

DUST CONTROL APPLICATIONS OPEN

Each year Saddle Hills County offers dust control treatments on roads in front of residences at a cost approved by Council. Rates for 2023 are as follows:

- Residential: \$200 (plus GST) per 100m
- Industrial: \$670 (plus GST) per 100m
