Bags are available from retailers at the time of purchase and a small inventory is kept on hand at participating transfer stations. Please bag your containers prior to drop-off, if possible.



A Burn Permit can be obtained from Alberta Ag and Forestry to discharge consumer fireworks in the Forest Protection Area during the Fire Season, March 1 - October 31.
