Opening of the Saddle Hills County Health Clinic

Saddle Hills County is pleased to announce that the greatly anticipated Saddle Hills County Health Clinic will be opening on June 17, 2024. The clinic is located at the Saddle Hills County Administration Building.

It is hoped that the establishment of the Saddle Hills County Health Clinic will relieve pressure on local Emergency Rooms and provide a local healthcare option for residents who currently don't have primary care physicians, experience long wait times or travel long distances to seek care.

To mark the opening of the Clinic, Saddle Hills County will be hosting a ‘Meet and Greet’ for the public on June 17, 2024, from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. There will be a chance to tour the clinic, ask questions, and meet the driving force behind the clinic, Nurse Practitioner, Palvi Sharma.

Upon commencement of services, the clinic will be open Monday to Thursday, from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. to residents or landowners in Saddle Hills County. The clinic will begin taking bookings on June 17, with a potential first appointment date of Tuesday, June 18, 2024. The phone line will not be operational before this time.
