CHILDCARE SUBSIDY UPDATE

At Saddle Hills County, we understand the need for families to be able to access quality and affordable child care. To help combat the cost, the County provides a Child Care Subsidy to eligible residents. The subsidy is paid on a per hour, per child basis, up to a monthly rate, as per the Master Rates Bylaw. Beginning January 1, 2026, the rate will be increasing to \$3.10 p/hour, p/child up to a maximum of \$520 p/month, p/child. For more information, visit saddlehills.ab.ca/Child-Care

A reminder to ratepayers that the final penalty deadline for 2025 property taxes, is December 31, 2025. After this date, a 6% penalty shall be placed on the total outstanding amount. This is in addition to any penalties previously accrued. If mailing in a cheque, the Canada Post date of mailing will determine the received payment date.
