2023 TAX PENALTY

A reminder to ratepayers that the final penalty deadline for 2023 property taxes is **December 31, 2023**. After this date, a 6% penalty shall be placed on the total outstanding amount. This is in addition to any penalties previously accrued. Payments can be made online through most financial institutions, over the phone, or by visiting us in the County office during regular office hours. Please use the drop-box after hours. If mailing in a cheque, the Canada Post date of mailing will determine the received payment date.

RURAL POTABLE WATER PROGRAM


