WEED INSPECTORS BEGIN WORK

Did you know that Saddle Hills County is at the heart of one of Canada's most important crop producing regions? To help ensure the high quality of our crops and eliminate pests, our Weed Inspectors carry out regular annual inspections, looking for noxious and prohibited weeds listed under the Weed Control Act and nuisance and pest species listed under the Agricultural Pests Act. So, if you see a County staff member in your field in the coming months, they are there to help! Weed Inspectors may park vehicles in field approaches but will never drive onto your land, and follow strict biosecurity protocols to prevent disease spread. BRIDGE REPAIR WORK DELAYS

Bridge repair work will commence on two trestle bridges in the Woking/Westmark area, beginning on June 1, 2023. The trestle bridge North of Woking, on Rge. Rd. 60 will begin June 1, followed by the trestle bridge North of the Westmark Hall, on Rge. Rd. 73 at Hwy. 677. There will be traffic delays and possible closures on both routes during this time, for approximately two weeks each, with completion scheduled for the end of June. We thank you for your patience.

CONSTRUCTION SEASON - EXPECT DELAYS

Construction is scheduled to take place on the following roads:

- Hwy 725 (Hwy 49 to Hwy 681) incl. Asphalt Paving: May 24 July
- Hwy 84 (Hwy 681 to Twp. Rd. 822) Asphalt Overlay: June July
- Hwy 115 (Pilsworth) (Hwy 49 to Hwy 681): **May 24 July 1** Drivers should expect delays on these routes throughout the construction period. We thank you for your patience.
