WORKING WELL WEBINAR - APR. 27

Saddle Hills County's Agricultural Services Department is hosting a FREE Working Well webinar on April 27, 2023 from 6:30-9:30 p.m. This comprehensive workshop will cover the basics of groundwater and how your well works, as well as information on how to protect your well, test your well water, operating and maintaining your well, what to do with old, abandoned wells on your property, and much more. Technical expertise will be provided by professionals

from Alberta Agriculture and Irrigation, Alberta Environment and Protected Areas, Alberta Health Services, and licensed well water contractors. Registration is required in advance.
