ALBERTA RCMP & ALBERTA RURAL CRIME WATCH APPS

The Alberta RCMP have launched a brand-new app for mobile devices, available on iOS and Android through the app store, called 'Alberta RCMP'. The app allows them to provide the public with online access to news, crime reporting, detachment locations, crime mapping and statistics, and a map for initiatives like Project Lock Up. It also provides access to partner law enforcement services, mental health supports, Crime Stoppers and links to AB RCMP social media accounts. For those interested there is also an 'Alberta Rural Crime Watch' app with information on online crime reporting, RCMP boundary maps, safety tips, and social services contacts.

RECYCLE - GRAIN BAGS, TWINE & PESTICIDE JUGS


Bonanza and Blueberry Transfer Stations continue to accept grain bags for recycling. Grain bags must be rolled tightly with a mechanical grain bag roller and secured with twine. Bonanza and Blueberry Transfer Stations have expanded recycling to include plastic twine. Clean plastic twine must be loosely placed in collection bags and placed in designated area at either transfer site. Bags are available at point of purchase or Bonanza and Blueberry Transfer Stations on days the sites are open. Empty, triple rinsed, punctured and bagged pesticide jugs with contents less than 23 litres are also accepted at Woking, Blueberry or Bonanza Transfer Stations. Bags are available at point of purchase or at the participating transfer stations. All empty jugs must be bagged prior to acceptance. Visit the County website for more news about this program.
