CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

- Work has begun on the Northmark Road (Township Road 764)
 Asphalt Paving Project. The project will see 5.6 km of the road paved, east from Range Road 70 to Highway 731. The project is due for completion by October 15, 2024.
- Slide repair is underway by the Doe River Bridge, on Range Road 134.
- Bridge culvert replacement on the Letersky Drainage Ditch began September 20, 2024. Range Road 72 is closed from Township Road 800 to Township Road 794 for construction. The road should re-open on **October 15, 2024**.
- Re-gravelling work continues on County roads.

Please watch out for workers and large equipment, slow down, and drive with caution through all construction zones.
