ELECTION WORKERS NEEDED

Saddle Hills County is seeking Election Workers for the upcoming 2025 Municipal Election. To be eligible to be an Election Worker, you must:

- Be eligible to work in Canada.
- Be at least 16 years of age.
- Be able to provide a satisfactory Criminal Records Check.
- Be able to attend the mandatory training session (September 26, 2025, at 10 a.m.)
- Be available all day on Election Day (October 20, 2025).

Election Workers will be paid a day rate of \$400, for each day worked during the election and mileage will be paid at \$0.70 per kilometer. To apply, visit saddlehills.ab.ca/Election-Workers. Deadline for applications is **August 31, 2025**.

A reminder that the deadline for 2025 property taxes is **July 31, 2025**. As of August 1, 2025, there will be a 6% penalty applied to the current year's outstanding tax balance. Payments can be made online through most financial institutions, at the office, or over the phone with a credit card. We accept credit cards, debit cards, and cheques.
