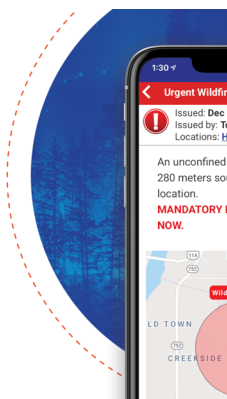
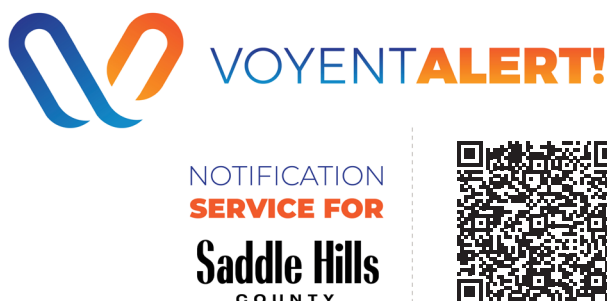

PRIVATELY-OWNED EQUIPMENT LIST

Contractors wanting to provide heavy equipment and gravel hauling services for Saddle Hills County, must register with the County annually by completing and submitting a Privately Owned Equipment Registration Form. These forms are available online at saddlehills.ab.ca/privately-owned-equipment, by scanning the QR code, or at the County Admin Building. You can register at any time, however; our construction season usually begins on, or around, April 1, and we urge interested contractors to submit their applications by **March 15, 2025**.
