DUST CONTROL APPLICATIONS OPEN

Each year, Saddle Hills County offers dust control treatments on roads in front of residences at a cost approved by Council. Rates for 2025 are as follows:

- Residential: \$200 (plus GST) per 100m
- Industrial: \$670 (plus GST) per 100m

If you are interested in dust control in front of your residence please complete the application, available on our website or at the County office, by **May 15, 2025**. If you have any questions or require assistance please contact Operations at (780) 864-3760.

2025 DO NOT SPRAY AGREEMENTS - NOW AVAILABLE

The tentative spray areas for 2025 are the Savanna, Fourth Creek, and Bonanza areas. If you do not wish to have the roadside beside your property sprayed by the County, you will need to complete a Do Not Spray Agreement. Do Not Spray Agreements are now available either online at saddlehills.ab.ca/weedcontrol or at the County office. The deadline to submit agreements is **May 30, 2025**, at 4:30 p.m.

2025 FENCELINE SPRAYING AGREEMENTS - NOW AVAILABLE

If you would like the fenceline along your property sprayed as part of our spraying program, you will need to complete a Fenceline Spraying Agreement. Fenceline Spraying Agreements are now available for 2025 either online at saddlehills.ab.ca/weedcontrol or at the County office. The deadline to submit agreements is **May 30, 2025**, at 4:30 p.m.
