TAX DEADLINE APPROACHING

A reminder that the deadline for 2025 property taxes is **July 31, 2025**. As of August 1, 2025, there will be a 6% penalty applied to the current year's outstanding tax balance. Payments can be made online through most financial institutions, at the office, or over the phone with a credit card. We accept credit cards, debit cards, and cheques.

ELECTION WORKERS NEEDED

Saddle Hills County is seeking Election Workers for the upcoming 2025 Municipal Election. To be eligible to be an Election Worker, you must:

- Be eligible to work in Canada.
- Be at least 16 years of age.
- Be able to provide a satisfactory Criminal Records Check.
- Be able to attend the mandatory training session (September 26, 2025, at 10 a.m.)
- Be available all day on Election Day (October 20, 2025). Election Workers will be paid a day rate of \$400, for each day worked during the election and mileage will be paid at \$0.70 per kilometer. To apply, visit saddlehills.ab.ca/Election-Workers. Deadline for applications is August 31, 2025.
